



Part VII

Frequently Asked Questions

These are explanations in Q & A formation and questions those are frequently asked by international students from Jeonju University to the department office or the Office of International Affairs. We hope that this will help you in your school life.

Q 01 How could it be the [Tuition Fee] if I take a stop-out after payment?

Stop-out before the start of the semester is transferred to the full semester of tuition and only apply for return to the expected semester. (After the semester begins, it will be handled by the refund policy.)

Q 02 [Tuition Fee] Can I take a stop-out without payment?

You can take a stop-out without paying the tuition fee. However, there are no scholarship benefits, such as grades or special scholarships, as there is no previous semester grade when returning.

Q 03 How long can I take [stop-out]?

Self-development and disease leave are up to 1 year, pregnancy, childbirth, and parental leave are within 2 years, and within 14 days after leave, you must leave Korea.

Q 04 [stop-out] Can I take a stop-out as a new comer?

New students can take a stop-out after completing one semester. However, it is possible to take a leave of illness, and if the doctor's diagnosis is over 4 weeks.

Q 05 I haven't been able to apply for [Enrollment]. What should I do ?

Course registration is generally one month before the start of the course (February and August), and there is a correction period in the first week of the course. In addition, you can cancel course registration during the start of the month (March, September).

Q 06 I cannot see a course name when I register for [Enrollment] ?

All subjects that students can take can be found in inSTAR. Please search by the number of academic subjects (code number) rather than by using the 'course name'.

Q 07 [Enrollment] There is no vacancy in the major or cultural class. What should I do?

All courses are limited by academic regulations. Therefore, you must participate quickly during the course registration period, and if you do not have a seat, please consult the department assistant teacher.

Q 08 [Enrollment] Do the international students have to take a chapel?

International students do not need to take a chapel. However, Christianity and culture must be taken among the cultural courses.

Q 09 I want to apply for [Multiple Major/Minor Major]. Is it possible for international students?

International students can apply for both majors and minors. For more information, please contact the body of the guidebook or the department office.

Q 10 [Graduation/TOPIK] Is there a valid TOPIK period for graduation requirements?

The validity period of TOPIK is 2 years, but if you have acquired TOPIK level 4 or higher after entering Jeonju University (Korean language training or undergraduate), you can graduate regardless of the validity period.

Q 11 [Graduation Certificate] When can I get it?

The graduation certificate is issued after the completion of the degree conferment in February or mid-August after the end of the last semester. Even if you enter the country before graduation, we cannot give you in advance, and we can accept your agent after confirmation.

Q 12 [Graduation Certificate] Can a friend receive it for me?

The graduation certificate is not issued until after the graduation semester ends and the degree awarding ceremony (February or August) ends. If a certificate is lost, it cannot be reissued and a proxy can be received after the consent of the person.

Q 13 [Graduation Certificate] Where can I get it?

Graduation certificates are kept in the department office for about one semester after graduation and afterwards are kept according to school regulations. You should go there as soon as possible.

Q 14 [Scholarship] Can international students receive a [Scholarship] if they complete the Superstar SP score?

International students are not included in the Superstar Scholarship Program. However, if you fill a certain number of SP points, you may be recommended for a self-improvement scholarship.

Q 15 [Tuition Fee] I can't pay because I don't have any money right now. What should I do?

According to school regulations, the tuition payment date is fixed, and the tuition payment is made before the 1st start, 2nd start, and 3 weeks after the 3rd start. Failure to pay will result in expulsion from school regulations.

Q 16 [Immigration] Can I stay more in Korea if the visa expire date remained?

The period of stay on the back of the alien registration card is 6months, 1year, or 2years depending on the status of residence, but must leave the school within 14 days of the completion of the school schedule due to dropout, stop-out, graduation, or completion.

Q 17 [Academic warning] If my academic record is poor, will I be expelled (expulsion)?

Academic warning is for those who have an average grade below 1.5 for each semester. Student whom received 3 academic warnings continuously are expelled.

Q 18 [Acknowledgment of attendance] I can't attend the class because I'm in the hospital. What should I do?

If you are unable to attend due to your injury or illness, please contact the professor in charge before class start and report the situations of yours then submit a certificate of hospitalization when you attend class.
