## 13. IMPORTANT NOTE FOR ADMISSION

- 1) All application documents must arrive on or before the deadline(~17:00) and the application fee shall be paid within the deadline
- 2) Jeonju University will not return documents submitted for admission. Please ensure that if applicants submit inaccurate, conflicting, misleading, false documents, the University has right to cancel admission
- 3) If there are missing document found during screening, then the application shall be withdrawn
- 4) If there are typos in the application documents or not answering during interview process that negatively affect applicants, the University shall not take responsibility

## 14. IMPORTANT NOTE FOR APPLICANT

- 1) All notices and admission announcement shall be posted on the University's website
- 2) All applicants must present in the waiting room a half an hour before the interview and are to be informed interview procedures
- 3) All applicants need to be aware of admission process then take an examination
- 4) The University shall take an action for wrongdoing applicants
  - a) Please follow the instruction by interviewer and committee members and do not disturb other applicants during admission process
  - b) It is not allowed to take an admission process on behalf of other applicants
  - c) It is prohibited to show or cheat applicants answering sheets
  - d) It is not allowed to have a conversation during the test or complete answering sheet by using mobile or other electronic devices

- e) It is not allowed to make false documents and other misbehaviour acknowledged by interviewers or committee members
- 5) If applicants who do not satisfy clause 3) that negatively affect, the University shall not take responsibilities
- 6) The University has a right to refund an application fee for the following reasons
  - a) In case that applicants pay an application fee more than 50,000 Korean Won(Exceeded amount to be refunded)
  - b) In case that applicants would not attend the admission process due to University imputation(Total amount to be refunded)
  - c) In case that applicants would not attend the admission process due to natural disaster(Total amount to be refunded)
  - d) In case that applicants would not attend the admission process due to unexpected disease or accident and need to be hospitalized or death(Total amount to be refunded if applicants can prove the incident)
